A warm welcome to new and existing netball players and families,

To those of you who are new to St Peter's Primary School Netball, our Netball Program is affiliated with the Noranda Netball Association at Noranda Netball Centre, Garson Court, Noranda.

As per last year, all player and member registrations are still handled online via My Netball (more information about the 'My Netball' process will be provided).

Teams are divided based on years:

- NetSetGo (NGS) Competition - Years 3 and 4.
- Juniors – Year 5&6 students.

Teams are generally made up of 8-9 players from the same school year group. However depending on the number of players available, a team may consist of players from two school year groups to make a sufficient team.

Games are played on Saturday morning and times will be announced closer to the season's commencement.

The netball winter season begins on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> APRIL and ends in August with finals in September.

#### **2) Login : Enter your netball ID and password**

*(If you have forgotten your child’s ID number perform a “Search” by entering your child’s name.*

#### **3) When you have logged in, scroll to the bottom left hand side. There will be subheading “Online Registration Forms” and click on the link “St Peters Registration Form 2019”**

#### **4) Follow the instruction to register your child**

#### **5) In the final step press “ Submit and Later” . You will receive an email to confirm your registration**

### **TEAM ORGANISATION**

Year 3: Children are able to nominate 2 friends they would like to be with in their team. Please email these requests to [netballstpeters@gmail.com](mailto:netballstpeters@gmail.com) by the 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2019.

Year 4: Team allocation will remain the same as the previous season, unless numbers change due to children leaving or joining the competition. Where possible, teams will be balanced based on defense and forward position players.

Year 5 and 6: Based on feedback from previous seasons, grading will occur for this age group. To ensure neutrality, grading will be outsourced to an independent body. Please note – the role of the netball committee is to facilitate the registration of the St Peters Netball teams and ensure smooth running of this volunteer run activity – the Committee is not involved in the grading process. If there is a shortage of players for a specific year group merging will be required.

Information about the date for Grading will be announced shortly – to ensure all players can participate.

### **UMPIRES**

If you are interested in umpiring or know someone who may be interested, please nominate your interest by emailing the committee or by contacting Laila Gizzarelli 0478 906 829. We have been fortunate in the past to have a number of parents and ex-St Peter's students assist us with umpiring. Umpires need a sound understanding of the rules and confident on the court.

New umpires are encouraged to participate in the Noranda Umpiring Squad Course held by Noranda Netball Association.









### **COACHES & ASSISTANT COACHES**

Coaching is voluntary, if you are interested in coaching or know someone who may be interested, please nominate your interest by emailing the committee or **by contacting Annalisa Hutchinson 0437 773 846 ASAP**. We have been fortunate in the past to have a number of parents and high school students take on this role and they have done a fantastic job; however parent participation is encouraged. Unfortunately if a coach cannot be arranged for a particular team/s, the Committee will be required to cancel that particular team.

During the season, parents who are not happy with a coach's or umpire's decision and ruling, are not to approach them, please see a Committee member to discuss the matter or dispute. **PLEASE REMEMBER COACHES, UMPIRES AND COMMITTEE MEMBERS ARE VOLUNTEERS** – If you are continually unhappy with their decision or actions – volunteer to assist.

## **TEAM MANAGERS**

The role of the Team Manager is to keep the team organised. They will:

-  Look after the team equipment.
-  Keep Bibs in good order and ensure they are returned at the end of each game (a simple airing of bibs with occasional washes will help keep elastics from fraying and becoming too loose).
-  Keep the Game ball inflated and ready for each game.
-  Arrange Orange & Scoring rosters for parents.
-  Distribute any notes to the players/parents.
-  Collect & Distribute money to umpires each week.
-  Organise end of season 'Team Wind Up' and assist the Committee with Trophy Presentation.
-  Clean and then return equipment at the end of the season.

## **TRAINING AND GAME DAY**

Training days and times are determined by the coach's availability. For training sessions, players are required to wear the school sports uniform or bring in sports clothes from home (shorts, t-shirt, sports shoes), water bottle and a snack. We ask that siblings are not left alone while training is on, due to Duty of Care.




Training is compulsory, and all players are expected to attend unless there is a legitimate reason. It is important for all players to commit to training, as coaches have volunteered their personal free time to help train the children. Parent assistance is also appreciated and encouraged.

If you are unable to train or participate in a Saturday game, please contact your coach ASAP.

The training venue is yet to be confirmed; however the school court is available for training this season.

## **UNIFORMS**

There is a strict dress code for Noranda Netball Association and the correct uniform is expected to be worn at all times. St Peter's has received advice that schools must play in the approved school uniform as per the Noranda Netball Constitution. St Peter's have registered the following uniform:

## CODE OF CONDUCT

St Peter's Netball is committed to good sportsmanship and playing guidelines – please make yourself familiar with these guidelines and explain in detail to your child what is expected of them, additionally explain to your child the commitment required for team sports and the team attitude required.

Once you have read through the Code of Conduct please make sure you and your child sign the attached registration form as your child will not be approved to play the first game if the form is not signed by both student and parent. This form will be required to be signed and given to your coach on the first day of training.

## PLAYERS AGREEMENT

Players will:

-  Honor their commitment to training and games each week.
-  Commit to playing in the team you are placed in, for the duration of the season.
-  Understand that every effort will be made by to ensure players are with one friend in their team, however they will be understanding if this isn't possible – due to player numbers etc.
-  Understand that training is compulsory; if you know that you will be unable to train you will need to accept that you may not play **“No Train No Game”**.
-  Remember that players are representing St Peter's, therefore appropriate behavior in line with the School Values is expected at all times. If Players are found to be acting inappropriately towards others, the situation and action taken, will be managed by the Committee, Noranda Netball Association and the School.
-  Show respect to Umpires at all times – Umpires are doing the best to their ability and sometimes this may go against you as a player and your team. Remember the school values of 'Trust and Respect'
-  Be expected to honor your financial commitment to the Netball Committee by having registration completed and fees paid by Friday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2019. No player will be allowed to play unless full payment has been made.
-  Understand that if they withdraw from Netball after the registration process has been completed – a full refund will not be possible (Please contact Annalisa for specific details)

## **NORANDA NETBALL ASSOCIATION CODE OF CONDUCT**

### **Participants who enter the Sue Belcher / Noranda Netball Association Complex**

- Will always play by the rules.
- Will never argue with an official. If there is a disagreement with a decision we will inform the captain, coach or manager during a break or after the competition.
- Will control our temper. We understand that verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players and deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviours in any sport.
- Will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Will be a good sport and applaud all good plays whether they are made by my team or the opposition.
- Will treat all players in my sport as we like to be treated. We will not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Will display modesty in victory and be gracious in defeat.
- Will not arrive at this venue intoxicated or drink alcohol or use drugs at the venue.

## **NORANDA NETBALL ASSOCIATION CONDITION OF ENTRY**

**By entering the Sue Belcher / Noranda Netball Association facility, all persons agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions.**

- **All persons** must conduct themselves in a proper and reasonable manner and in accordance with the Noranda Netball Association Codes of Conduct. A copy of which is available in the netball information book.
- By entering, all persons agree to be bound by the Noranda Netball Association's constitution, rules and by-laws. Also, submit themselves to any Member Protection Tribunal and any other disciplinary forum connected with Netball.
- All types of cameras are prohibited in any change rooms.
- Parents, Spectators, Umpires and players entering agree to comply with any reasonable direction of any official connected with Noranda Netball Association
- The right to remove any person from this facility is reserved if the person's behaviour is considered dangerous or unacceptable to the Noranda Netball Association.
- Any person using or under the influence of Alcohol or Drugs is prohibited from entering or remaining on these premises.
- Smoking is prohibited in any area of this facility and court area.
- We understand and accept that there are consequences if we break any one of the code of conduct rules.
