



St Peter's School – Inglewood P & F Scholarships for 2021

Each year, the St Peter's P&F Association offers three scholarships to students involved in sporting activities, the arts and the community. The aim of these three scholarships is to encourage and support children who display aptitude and talent in an area of the arts, sports or community.

“Bev Ravenscroft Scholarship for the Arts”

The Bev Ravenscroft Scholarship is offered to children who are involved in the arts and may include music, drama, dance, art or any other aspect of the arts (previous winners have been involved in music, ballet and art).

“Bernadette Preston Sports Scholarship”

The Bernadette Preston Sports Scholarship is offered to children who are involved in a particular sporting activity (previous winners have been involved in a variety of sports at a State and National level, though achievements at this level are not a prerequisite for the awarding of the scholarship).

“Joe Tavelli TRUE Values Scholarship”

The Joe Tavelli TRUE Values scholarship is offered to children who have exhibited the values of Trust, Respect, Unity and Excellence outside the school community (this may involve a voluntary activity relating to a charity, sporting club or community group).

The successful candidates will have their 2021 Tuition Fee covered by this Scholarship.

How to Apply

If your child is involved in the arts or a particular sport and you consider he/she possesses an aptitude or talent for that activity, it would be worthwhile applying for one of these scholarships.

If your child is actively involved within the community and you believe he/she exhibits the values of Trust, Respect, Unity and Excellence, it would be worthwhile applying for this scholarship.

Considerations taken into account by those involved in the selection process when selecting the scholarship recipient:

- Engagement and participation in St Peter's Primary School programs.
- Representation of the School in events (for example, PAF, Interschool Carnivals etc).
- Attitudes, behaviour and sportsmanship.
- Achievements outside the School.
- Engagement and participation within the School community and outside community.
