UNIFORM STANDARDS

- Children should wear their school uniform correctly, with a note of explanation if the correct uniform is unavailable. Should any child wear the incorrect uniform without written notification from his/her parent/caregiver, a uniform infringement notice will be sent home by the Classroom Teacher. Should this matter be reoccurring, an Assistant Principal will make contact with the parent.
- All items of clothing should be clearly marked with the child's name – including surname.
- Hats with the school crest must be worn at all times when the student is outdoors.
- All children are to wear clean, tidy school uniforms.
- School socks must be worn. They are to be visible, not hidden in school shoes (no sports socks with black shoes).
- School pants must be worn correctly. They are not to be worn low, so that boxer shorts, etc are visible.
- As part of the winter uniform, the school tie must be worn correctly.
- Nail polish is not allowed.
- The only jewellery permitted is a watch, a pair of studs/sleeper earrings (to be worn in both ears) and a fine necklace with a cross.
- Writing on the body with pen, texta, etc is not permitted.
- Writing on the school uniform or altering the school uniform in any way is not permitted.

SCHOOL WET WEATHER JACKET: The School Wet Weather Jacket is optional and may be worn to and from school, recess and lunch times only, not in class. No other wet weather jacket can be worn in Years 1 to 6. Please note that this jacket does not replace the wearing of the school jumper.

BACKPACK: All students are required to use the St Peter's Primary School backpack.

GROOMING AND ACCESSORIES:

- Hair must be neat and styled in a manner in keeping with primary school standards.
- Students with hair longer than collar length are to wear their hair tied back.
- All hair must be clean with fringes above eyebrow length.
- Hair is to be tied back with maroon or white elastics, ribbons, scrunchies or headbands (no logos or licensed merchandise). On sports days, the student can wear hair accessories of his/her faction colour only (no flowers, butterflies, etc).
- 'Fad' haircuts and hairstyles (zig-zag stripes, shaved patches, rats' tails, excessive hair gel and haircuts shorter than a number 2 do not align with our School Policy).
- A simple watch and one pair of plain studs or sleepers (one in each ear) is permitted.
- A cross or religious medal on a gold/silver chain can be worn under clothing.
- All other jewellery (rings, bracelets, bangles etc.) is not to be worn as it poses a hazard in school and sporting activities.
- Makeup and/or nail polish are not part of our school uniform.

All items (except sport shoes and school shoes) are to be purchased from Uniform Concepts Inglewood Superstore, 834 Beaufort Street, Inglewood. The Superstore is open six days per week (Monday – Friday 9am-5pm, and Saturday 9am – 1pm).

- Pre-owned items need to have the previous owner's name removed before being renamed.
- Children often accidentally pick up wrong items of clothing. Please check that what they are wearing actually belongs to them.
- All children are expected to be in complete and correct school uniform from the beginning of each term.
