Join the adventure!

We encourage you to join us in unlocking the wonderful world of reading for your children. Help them to join the Premier's Reading Challenge. Will they fly above the clouds, dive into the ocean or jump into a rocket ship? All students from Kindergarten to Year 6 are challenged to read 12 books by 9 September 2022.

You can help your children sign up via the website, choose their own avatar and log all the books they read over the course of the Challenge. Weekly prizes will be awarded to students who log a book that week, with major prizes drawn when the challenge ends.

Books don't have to be in English – children are encouraged to read books in their first language.

There are extraordinary tourism prizes to be won each week.

At St Peter's we are excited to be introducing a TUESDAY BOOKCLUB to support and encourage this wonderful initiative. During lunch time, children can settle into our special reading space and spend time, diving into books and reading for pleasure. Students will be encouraged to add the books, they have completed reading for pleasure, to a class tally. Each week at assembly, progress will be announced. The Literacy Team will host a monthly celebration for the winning class.

Newsletter READING TIP Week 5: **UNLOCKING THE WONDERFUL WORLD OF READING TOGETHER**



Step 1. CREATING A POSITIVE & FUN EXPERIENCE

Make time to read a book TOGETHER.

Decide on a time each day to read together (even if it is just 5 minutes)

Create a comfortable space to read.

Share the reading: Parents, extended family members, sibling all take turns to read the chosen book.

For those early readers, still developing reading skills, try 'Echo Reading' (where they read along with you).

Read a sentence each or leave a predictable word for the early and young reader to insert into the story.

Talk about what happens or your favourite part of the story.

READ, LAUGH and IMMERSE YOURSELF in the STORY!
