**Week 5: August 15 -19<sup>th</sup> is National Science Week and we have some exciting activities planned at St Peter's.**




- **Class activities on glass during Science lessons from PP-Year 6**

### "Glass" National Science Week Competition

WALT: Glass! More than meets the eye!!

WILF: I can create something new with glass and explain its purpose.

1. As part of Science Week 2022 we are having a competition to see how creative and innovative you can be with glass. This will be completed at home and I suggest you discuss your idea with an adult. This is to make sure you are using correct safety precautions when working with any materials.
  2. Select a pre-used / recycled piece of glass. For example: a glass jar, bottle, bowl or a panel from a photo frame are possible suggestions. Using your creativity turn your glass piece into something new and amazing. Be sure to plan and think carefully before you start.
  3. Take a  of your finished masterpiece and new creation and show me. Using  briefly explain what you have made. Tap 
  4. Bring your masterpiece of glass to school carefully to our new library on 18<sup>th</sup> August, Thursday morning and place it in your class section. You **MUST** have your name, class and a brief explanation attached.
- **Dress Up - As Science week coincides with Book Week, if students would like to dress up as something related to Science, they can choose to do this on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> as part of Book Week. The choice is theirs.**
  - **Assembly - This will include a Video of the week, competition winners, and a few other surprises.**
